# **Immersive Learning Project with Community Partner: Second Harvest Food Bank**

Partnering with Second Harvest Food Bank in Spring 2021, this Immersive Learning Project aimed to examine the needs of the community through application of sociological knowledge to synthesize research and literature. Students in this Immersive Learning Project completed all survey, interview, and informed consent documents, as well as compiling a literature review to aide in understanding sociological themes. They collected data from Second Harvest "Big Idea" Events by administering these surveys and interviews. They then synthesized their findings and presented the research to their community partner: Second Harvest Food Bank. Second Harvest will then use this research to earn grants and gain a better understanding of how COVID-19 impacted food insecurity in Indiana.
