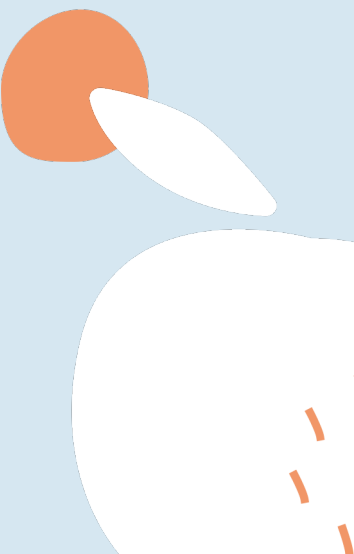




Sugar Crush

- Cookie kits \$170



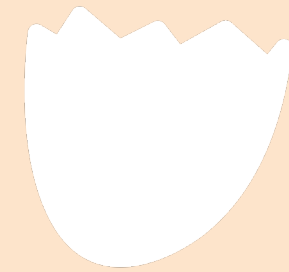
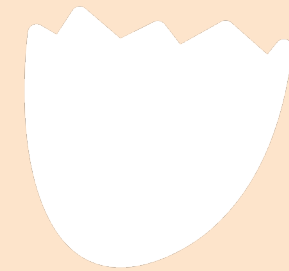
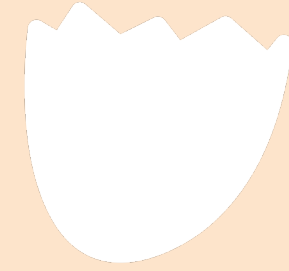
Budget



- Cupcakes from Charmed Cupcake \$36/dozen, total \$108. (3 Dozen)
- GF Cupcakes from Sea Salt & Cinnamon 1/2 dozen, total \$20
- Vegan Cupcakes from Sea Salt & Cinnamon 1/2 dozen, total \$18
- GF cookies from Se Salt & Cinnamon 21/dozen, total \$42 (2 Dozen)
- Take Home Cookie Mix Jars (17 @ 7.50/each) total \$127.50
